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What have we done?

1st GPP Training

Training 1 – National - Public procurers from central administration bodies; regional and local public procurers


Training 2 – Centro Region - Regional and local public procurers, hospitals, university schools; regional procurement agencies

Nov 2019 – Jun 2020 (Covid 19)

20+20 participants

20h training, 4 sessions, 1 face-to-face, 3 online, each divided into 2 parts





What have we done?

2nd GPP Training

National - Public procurers from central administration bodies; regional and local public procurers April 2023 - January 2024

25 participants, 25 certificates

24h training, 5 sessions, 1 face-to-face, 4 online, each divided into 2 parts. 2 month between each session





Lessons learned

- Besides the topics covered by the GPP Training Curriculum, some complementary modules were added by LNEG
 that corresponded to actual training needs revealed by the trainees it is important to perceive
 trainers needs and expectations!
- Hands-on working groups developing tender documents for different product groups. Each
 group presented the procurement procedure they worked on and we had a discussion on the results. Participants
 showed a big deal of interest in this activity, and working groups allowed people to know each other
 and develop collaboration routines outside the training.
- Interactive activites using different platforms as mentimeter, jamboard, etc keeps the interest and allows the collection of feedback
- Online sessions allowed participants from all regions without travel expenses
- Starting by online sessions allowed participants to know each other first and the last sessions, which was face-to-face, allowed people to go further on interpersonal relationships
